

NOTICE

Please note that pursuant to 26 N.C.A.C. 05 .0205, the North Carolina Interpreter and Transliterator Licensing Board (the "Board") is requesting the North Carolina Rules Review Commission (the "RRC") to consider its periodic review of the Board's Rules one month earlier because the Board's legal counsel plans to be out of town during the originally scheduled meeting. Specifically, the Board is requesting the RRC to move the date of consideration from the RRC's meeting scheduled for June 15, 2017, to its meeting scheduled for May 18, 2017.

The Board's request to move the date is scheduled for consideration by the RRC during its April 20, 2017 meeting. If you object to the requested rescheduling, you may contact the RRC to object to the rescheduling.

This Notice is being provided to comply with 26 N.C.A.C. 05 .0205(b), which requires as follows:

An agency seeking earlier review shall, on the date of submission of the request to the Commission, post notice on its website and notify its interested persons mailing list maintained pursuant to G.S. 150B-21.2(d) of the meeting date on which the Commission will review its request as set forth in Paragraph (e) of this Rule. The notice shall also inform the public that the individuals may contact the Commission to object to the rescheduling.
