

NCITLB Requirements for Licensure Rev. 11-2014

Full AND Provisional Licensure requires ALL of the following:

1. Completed Application Form/signed and notarized
2. Current photograph, 2 inch by 2 inch (Passport size)
3. Photocopy of current picture identification that includes your date of birth (eg. Driver License)
4. Authority for Release form (for background check)
5. Completed fingerprint card
6. \$225.00 certified check, cash or money order made out to NCITLB for licensure fee
7. \$38.00 certified check, cash or money order made out to NCITLB (separate from licensure fee) for background check

Provisional Licensure additionally requires ONE of the following:

1. Valid National Association of the Deaf (NAD) Level II or III Credential
2. Holds a current Educational Interpreter Performance Assessment (EIPA) Level 3 or above classification
3. Holds a North Carolina Interpreter Classification System (NCICS) Level C Classification
4. Certified Deaf Interpreter (CDI) that completes 30 hours of training including, "Role & Function", "Code of Ethics" and interpreting professional studies coursework
5. Oral Interpreter that completes 40 hours of training in interpreting coursework/workshops related to oral interpreting
6. Cued Speech provider in interpreting/transliterating services that completes 40 hours of training in interpreting coursework/workshops related to cued speech
7. Person providing interpreting/transliterating services that has a recognized credential from another state in the field of interpreting/transliterating
8. Holds at least a two-year **interpreting** degree from a regionally accredited institution
9. Interpreter/transliterating that has accumulated 200 hours per year in the provision of interpreting/transliterating services in this state or another state totaling 400 hours for the two years immediately preceding the date of their application

Full Licensure additionally requires ONE of the following:

1. Valid National Association of the Deaf (NAD) Level IV or V certification (NAD certification is considered RID Certified)
2. Valid Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf, Inc. (RID) Certification
3. Valid CLTSLA Certificate Level 3 or higher.
4. Holds North Carolina Interpreter Classification System (NCICS) Level A or B Classification Level
